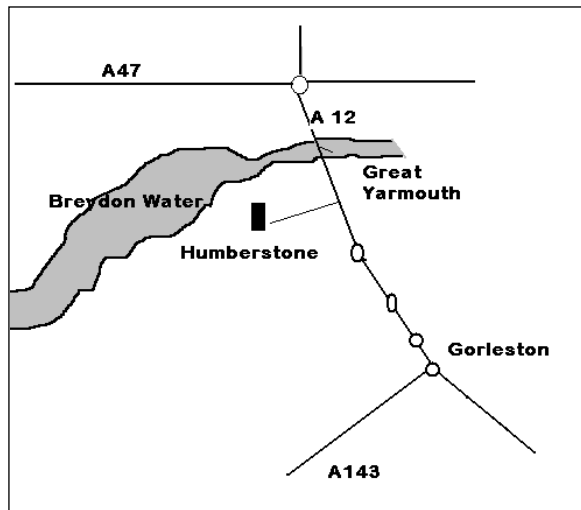

A correctly fitted riding hat (EN1384, ASTM F 1163 or PAS015 or higher) must be worn at all times by anyone mounted on a horse/pony. It is recommended that back protectors be worn in jumping classes. Any animal not under control or in any way constituting a danger may be asked to leave the showground. Owners enter their horses/ponies at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to Humberstone Equestrian Centre or the show organisers.

Ring one

Starts 9am. Entries £5, or £6 on the day. Rosettes 1st-6th.

- Class 1 - Best turnout, ridden and in-hand.
- Class 2 - Leading rein pony, 12.2hh & under. Rider 10 years and under.
- Class 3 - Riding/Hunter pony, 14.2hh and under.
- Class 4 - Mountain and Moorland, small/large breeds.
- Class 5 - Riding club pony, 14.2hh and under.

Championship for above classes 1st and 2nd

- Class 6 - Riding club horse, 14.2hh and over.
- Class 7 - Any breed, pure/part bred.
- Class 8 - Riding Horse, Hunter type or Cob over 14.2hh.
- Class 9 - Coloureds, Skewbald, Piebald, Tricolour, Spots, Palaminos, Duns, Roans and Cremello.
- Class 10 - Family horse or pony.

Championship for above classes 1st and 2nd. Supreme ridden for Champions/Reserves.

Ring One - In-hand showing

Starts approx. 2:30pm. Entries £3, or £4 on the day. Rosettes 1st-6th.

- Class 11 - Mountain and Moorland, small breeds.
- Class 12 - Mountain and Moorland, large breeds.
- Class 13 - Any breed pure/part bred.
- Class 14 - Best condition horse/pony.
- Class 15 - Veteran horse/pony, over 15 years.

Championship for above classes 1st and 2nd.

Ring Two - In-hand showing

Starts 9am. Entries £5, or £6 on the day. Rosettes 1st-6th.

- Class 16 - Hunter type, horse and pony.
- Class 17 - Coloureds, Skewbald, Piebald, Tricolour, Spots, Palaminos, Duns, Roans and Cremello.
- Class 18 - Youngstock, any breed 1,2 or 3 years.
- Class 19 - Novice horse/pony & handler, not to have been 1st or 2nd.
- Class 20 - Competition /dressage horse/pony. To be judged on conformation and manners, each competitor to walk and trot in a triangle from A-B-C-A.

Championship for above classes 1st and Supreme ridden for Champions/Reserves

Ring two - Fun Classes

Starts approx 12pm. Entries £3, or £4 on the day. Rosettes 1st-6th.

- Class 21 - Prettiest mare
- Class 22 - Most handsome gelding
- Class 23 - Nicest eyes
- Class 24 - Longest tail
- Class 25 - Smallest Ears
- Class 26 - Thelwell type
- Class 27 - Best six legs
- Class 28 - Horse/pony most like it's handler
- Class 29 - Best junior handler 16 years and under
- Class 30 - Best senior handler over 16 years

Championship for above classes 1st and 2nd.
